The City of Fitchburg, Department of Public Works, advises residents of the following work that is scheduled to be done – weather permitting – during the week of February 17.

No work is scheduled for President's Day. City Hall & the DPW administration offices are closed on February 17<sup>th</sup>, but will have normal business hours otherwise.

Water Meter Upgrade Project in all wards; Monday – Saturday, 8 AM to 4 PM:

Baystate Winsupply is the only Contractor for this ongoing project. Baystate Winsupply will be replacing and installing new water meters inside buildings and homes throughout the City. Customers are notified via U.S. postal mail. Once a customer is notified by Baystate Winsupply, there will be instructions to make appointments for meter replacement through a website or over the phone.

Road & Water Line Work; Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM. Expect lane closures and Minor traffic impacts:

- Pothole repair in all wards

- Spot sanding in all wards
- Inspecting and cleaning curb stop boxes in all wards
- Excavation and repair of curb stop box in the area of 104 Causeway Street
- Excavation and repair of curb stop box in the area of 362 Wanoosnoc Road
- Sewer Cleaning and Television Inspection in all wards.

Hydrant Work; Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM. Minor traffic impacts:

- Winterizing and inspecting fire hydrants on the High System (fire hydrants with red tops/bonnets) in all wards

As part of Unitol's Storm Resiliency Program, Asplundh will be trimming trees in the areas of: Klondike Street, Pearl Street, and Townsend Street for the next few weeks. Closer to the end of February and through out March they will be working in the areas of: High Street, Mount Vernon Street, and Simmonds Street.
