The City of Fitchburg, Department of Public Works, advises residents of the following work that will be done – weather permitting – during the week of March 30.

The Water Meter Upgrade Project is currently on hold until further notice due to the COVID-19 outbreak.

Street Sweeping; Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM:

- Daytime spot sweeping in ward 4. Please place sand for sweeper in windrows, not piles

Road Work; Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM. Minor traffic impacts:

- Pothole repairs in all wards
Use SeeClickFix.com or call 978-829-1900 to report a pothole
- Sidewalk construction on Franklin Rd & Oak Hill Rd
- Catch basin repairs on Falulah St & Lunenburg St
- Sewer manhole installations on Water St between Normandy Rd and Newton St.
Expect road closures and detours.
- Inspecting, cleaning, and repairing curb stop and gate boxes in all wards.
- Gas main work by Unitil/NEUCO on First St. Road will be closed.
- Milling and paving of Rte 2A at John Fitch Hwy by MassDOT's contractor beginning on Wednesday 4/1.

Temporary Road Closure/Detour:

- On Monday 3/30 and Tuesday 3/31 parts of Princeton Rd (Rte 31) will be closed due to construction activity.
- Princeton Rd (Rte 31 South at Rte 2A) will be closed to thru traffic leading onto Princeton Rd (Rte 31). Traffic will be detoured onto Westminster St (Rte 2A).
- Princeton Rd (Rte 31 north) will be closed at 5th Mass Turnpike and open to local traffic only after that point.
- The closure of Princeton Road (Rt. 31) will be just south of the Route 2A intersection to tear down the mill tower next to Whitman River. The road will be closed to allow for cranes and trucks to demolish the building.
- Please find alternate routes. Detours will be in place from 7:00 AM until 5:00 PM.
- Police officers will be stationed at each detour to assist with alternate routes.
- Digital and regular signage will be posted in the area to assist with the safe flow of traffic.
