The City of Fitchburg, Department of Public Works, advises residents of the following work that will be done – weather permitting – during the week of September 28, 2020.

City-wide water meter upgrade project: The City's contractor Baystate Winsupply will be installing new water meters throughout the City Monday thru Saturday 8 AM – 4 PM. Customers are <u>notified via U.S. mail</u> and asked to make appointments for meter replacement through a website or over the phone.

Road Construction: Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM. Expect road closures, delays and detours.

- Construction on Beech Street will continue with the raising of structures and paving.
- Roadway reconstruction on Crawford St from the Nashua River to the Leominster line will continue all
 week. The City's contractor will be milling and paving starting at 3 AM on Monday thru the end of day
 Tuesday.
- Installation of handicap ramps on Water Street and Granite Street.
- Paving on Ashby West Road will resume on Tuesday and continue for several weeks.
- Gas main work by Unitil/NEUCO which may result in road closures and detours will continue all week in the areas of:
 - o Electric Ave from Old Deerfield Road to Milk Street
 - o Legros Street from Beech Street to Madison Street

Street Sweeping: Monday - Friday 7 AM - 3 PM

- Spot sweeping City Wide.
- Residents are asked to sweep sidewalks in front of their properties.
- Sand should be placed in windrows and not in piles so that the equipment can successfully remove it.

Maintenance Work: Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM. Minor traffic impacts:

- Pothole repairs in all wards.
- Sewer cleaning & TV of various locations Monday Friday 7 AM 3 PM. Expect loud truck noise, localized detours and lane shifts.
- Sewer repairs on Elm Street- Oliver Street to Hartwell Street. Monday Friday 7 AM 5 PM. Expect road closures and construction noise.
- Manhole cover repairs on John Fitch Highway at Pearl Hill Road. Expect road closures and detours.
- Repair water gate boxes at various locations throughout the City.
- Unitil will have tree crews in the areas of Blossom Street and High Street, Charles Street and Rollstone Street all week.

Hydrants:

 Hydrant flushing on the high system (hydrants with red tops) in the area of Ashby State Road, including all side/interconnecting streets.
